



GOD Judges Belshazzar for His Pride - Monday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Daniel 5:1-4

In the start of *Daniel 5*, we have a new king. Belshazzar was very prideful, just like Nebuchadnezzar had been. He thought that nobody could get through the city's massive walls, and that they could not be starved out because of a river that flowed through the city.



Review: What happened to King Nebuchadnezzar because of his pride (4:33)?

How many people were at Belshazzar's feast (v 1)? ______ Belshazzar ordered special cups to be brought to use for the wine. What was special about these cups (v 2)? _____

When they drank the wine, who did they praise (v 4)? _____

Application:

Belshazzar was very prideful. He thought nobody could beat him. He also dared to "show God" that he was not scared of HIM, either. A thousand people were there, too. Most of those people knew what happened to King Nebuchadnezzar. They chose to drink from the cups and worship false gods, as well.

Yet, throughout everything you've read about Daniel, he has not shown any anger, or a rebellious attitude toward the rulers. Even now, as Belshazzar reminds Daniel of his captivity, Daniel comes as a servant.

Under Nebuchadnezzar, Daniel had been placed over all the wise men. Now, Belshazzar is promising to give Daniel even greater power and influence. This was a great opportunity for an exile. What did Daniel think about the gifts (v 17)?

This story reminds me of Joseph who was sold into slavery, falsely accused and imprisoned, and yet was used by God to deliver a message to a foreign ruler. Even though they were mistreated by others, they served others with humility. *Romans* 12:14-21 tells us to do the same:

Just as their gods could not see, hear, or know, Belshazzar and his guests could not see, hear, or know God. Daniel told Belshazzar that God held Belshazzar's breath in His hand (v 23). What do you think this means?

Application:

Whether or not you think about this, God holds your breath in His hand, too. He has already determined how many days you'll live on this earth, when you'll die and how you'll die, and there is nothing you can do to know when that day is, stop that day from coming, or extend your life beyond that day. You're not God and so you don't deserve to be treated as God. Humble yourself before God today. *Matthew* 6:9–10 ($^{(ESV)}-^9$ Pray then like this: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. ¹⁰ Your kingdom come, ______ be _____, on earth as it is in heaven" ...including in your life.


