



#### GOD Humbles Nebuchadnezzar - Tuesday

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read:** Daniel 4:4-18

#### Application:

Only Daniel was able to help Nebuchadnezzar because God had placed His Spirit in him. #### GOD Humbles Nebuchadnezzar - Wednesday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Daniel 4:19-26
In these verses, Daniel (Belteshazzar) tells Nebuchadnezzar what God wanted to tell him through this dream. Daniel was "alarmed" by the dream and wished that the dream was really about Nebuchadnezzar's enemies, but who did Daniel say was the big tree (v 22)?
How does the great and strong tree picture Nebuchadnezzar's rule (v 22)?
Draw a picture of what is going to happen to Nebuchadnezzar because of his pride (v 25)?
Will this be the end of Nebuchadnezzar's reign on the earth (v 26)?
Application:
On Monday, you read James 4:6, "But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, 'God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble.'"
This is also something that God had told all of the Israelite kings: 1 Samuel 2:3–10, " <sup>3</sup> Talk no more so very p, let not a come from your mouth; for the LORD is a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed. <sup>4</sup> The bows of the m
are broken, but the feeble bind on strength <sup>9</sup> He will guard the feet of
his faithful ones, but the wicked shall be coin darkness,
for not by m shall a man prevail. <sup>10</sup> The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; against them he will thunder in heaven.
The LORD will judge the ends of the earth"

God made you. He knows everything about you, and He will judge you someday. If you don't live in humility before God, He WILL go against you and your plans. He IS ALL-Mighty, and He WILL have HIS way.

#### GOD Humbles Nebuchadnezzar - Thursday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Daniel 4:27

Nebuchadnezzar thought very highly of himself, but God gave him a troubling dream to warn him through Daniel. He would lose his kingdom and live as an animal. Can you imagine how humiliating it would be for Nebuchadnezzar? Here's a description of his reign:

"Apart from his military conquests, Nebuchadnezzar is noteworthy for a massive rebuilding program in Babylon itself. The city spanned the Euphrates and was surrounded by an 11-mile long outer wall that enclosed suburbs and Nebuchadnezzar's summer palace. The inner wall was wide enough to accommodate two chariots abreast. It could be entered through eight gates, the most famous of which was...decorated with reliefs of dragons and bulls in enameled brick. The road to this gate was bordered by high walls decorated by lions in glazed brick behind which were defensive citadels. Inside the gate was the main palace... with its huge throne room. A cellar with shafts in part of the palace may have served as the substructure to the famous 'Hanging Gardens of Babylon,' described...as one of the wonders of the ancient world."

Daniel didn't promise that repentance would change God's plans, but he still encouraged Nebuchadnezzar to repent and seek God's mercy.

Revelation 19:5–8, "5 And from the throne came a voice saying, 'Praise our God, all you his s\_\_\_\_\_\_, you who f\_\_\_\_\_ him, small and great... Tet us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready; 8 it was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and p\_\_\_\_\_\_...'" God's challenge to you? 2 Peter 3:9, "The Lord...is patient toward you...that all should reach repentance." Repent of your sins today!

#### GOD Humbles Nebuchadnezzar - Saturday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read:** Daniel 4:34-37

How did Nebuchadnezzar view God and what did he do after 7 years (v 34)?

At the very moment that Nebuchadnezzar had been glorying in his selfmade kingdom, God took his glorious kingdom away from Nebuchadnezzar.

He said he "was established" and that "greatness was added to me". He didn't establish himself, and he didn't make himself great. These things were done to him by God's will and ways.
